

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the fork carriage hoisting capacity, there are four sizes of hook type tine carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is about thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold loads as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold loads up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted blades vary by the amount of offset between the blade and the tine eye. Some makers will differ the carriages for pin type blades. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
